The South Dartmoor & South Hams Covid-19 Local Vaccination Service is relocating to Follaton House in Totnes from 7th April to enable an expansion of the vaccine programme. In order to increase our capacity we now need registered vaccinators to step forward in the continued fight against coronavirus and help to deliver an effective Covid-19 vaccination programme. Our new vaccinator workforce will supplement the practice staff and volunteers who have already delivered in excess of 30,000 Covid-19 vaccines this year.

We are looking to recruit from our local communities to enable us to provide a safe and effective vaccination programme while continuing to offer timely access and minimal impact on other NHS services.

You will be working from Follaton House in Totnes, under the clinical leadership of a Lead GP. You will be fully briefed and given training will be provided on Covid-19 vaccines. In the meantime, you can prepare by ensuring you are up to date with any annual immunisation training as part of your registered professional training. This advert is for Bank work and you will work as and when required, with flexibility to choose your shifts within the constraints of the service. We operate seven days a week from 08.30 – 18.30. Please note - if successful you will receive an offer from Leatside Surgery as Lead Practice for the programme.

Your main responsibilities whilst on duty will be:

- Administering the Covid-19 Vaccine (at present Pfizer and Astra Zeneca)
- Assisting with the setup of your vaccination station
- Assist the Clinical supervisor when required – May be delegated the role of support to clinical supervisor as a 'second checker' for safe removal of vaccine vials from fridge (This will include record keeping)
- Conducting clinical assessments
- Reviewing complex medical histories and potential adverse reactions
- Preparation of the vaccine prior to administration
- Ensuring the best possible clinical outcomes by using up-to-date skills and adhering to local and national policies and procedures



Requirements:

- Proof of NMC/ GMC registration, identification and reference
- Completion of basic life support and anaphylaxis training
- Two references
- Competent to administer vaccines
- Completed online training for Pfizer and Astra Zeneca vaccines
- DBS Check
